**RE: PETITION AGAINST STERLING PETROCHEMICALS AND  
FERTILIZERS LIMITED: AN APPEAL FOR LEGISLATIVE  
INTERVENTION TO SAVE THE FAMILIES OF OKON ETUKUDO UKO  
AND UDO AMAKA INAM FROM FURTHER HARASSMENT,  
INTIMIDATION AND MOLESTATION**

### 1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The Okon Etukudo Uko and Udo Amaka Inam Families are land and oil palm plantation owners/families in Okopedi-Ete, Ikot Abasi Local Government Area of Akwa Ibom State, the community or village where Sterling Petrochemicals and Fertilizers Limited has her operational base and perhaps headquarters.
- 1.2 Sterling Petrochemicals and Fertilizers Limited is in Indian company registered in Nigeria and it engages in oil and gas exploration and drilling and the production/manufacture of fertilizers.

1.3 On establishing itself in Okopedi-Ete Community or village, the company has been engaging in wanton and unbridled scrambling and grabbing of lands within and outside Okopedi-Ete village. Part of the lands forcefully grabbed and taken by the said company are the family lands and oil palm plantations of Okon Etukudo Uko and Udo Amaka Inam Families.

The said company entered the said family lands, oil palm plantations with the aid, cover and protection of soldiers, graded, excavated and buried large oil pipelines without the consent and authority of the families concerned, consequently completely altering the nature of the lands, uprooting and destroying the oil palm trees and other economic trees/ crops on the lands which the families depended on for their sustenance and as their sources of livelihood, being poor peasants in an agricultural and rural community.

## 2.0 LITIGATIONS:

2.1 Consequent upon the acts of impunity and the unbridled brigandage aided by armed soldiers, the families after all efforts to secure adequate compensation from the company failed, went to court to seek redress.

### OKON ETUK UDO UKO FAMILY:

2.2 Okon Etukudo Uko family took an action in suit **NO. HAB/2/2025: MR. UKO OKON UKO V STERLING PETROCHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS LIMITED**. In the course of proceedings, the company pleaded for an amicable settlement out of court which the family accepted. Both parties agreed on the terms of settlement and endorsed the same which was filed and adopted in court upon which the court entered a consent Judgment. Please find the **Terms Of Settlement** duly annexed hereto as **Annexure 1** and the **Consent Judgment Order** as **Annexure 2**. Despite the duly agreed, endorsed and adopted terms of settlement and the consent judgment entered by the court the company has refused to honour the terms of settlement and consent judgment till date, instead has chosen to encroach upon and grab another land belonging to the family with the aid of armed soldiers.

2.3 The land grab of Okon Etukudo Uko family land stated in 2021 which led to the deceased owner/occupant/user of the land to cry out for compensation, yet the company refused. Please find annexed hereto as **Annexure 3**, the letter requesting for payment of compensation to the company written by the deceased Elder Okon Etukudo Uko which fell on deaf oars.

2.4 Please also find annexed as follows:

- (i) Record of proceedings in suit No. HAB/2/2025 when both parties entered the witness box to adopt the terms of settlement in open court as **Annexure 4**.
- (ii) **Annexures 5-9** are pictures of the oil palm plantation before the act of invasion, brigandage and destruction carried out by the company.
- (iii) **Annexures 10-31** are pictures of the company's workers, machines and equipment working on the land and the state of the land after the acts of brigandage and destruction. It is pertinent to observe that inspite of an order of injunction restraining the company from working or entering the land to work, the company defied the court order and kept working on the land as **Annexures 10-31** show.

### 3.0 PRAYERS SOUGHT:

3.1 An order directing the company to honour and implement the terms of settlement and consent judgment by:

- (i) Paying to the family through her Solicitor the sum of N30 Million as agreed upon in the terms of settlement and pronounced upon in the consent judgment.
- (ii) Payment of 10% monthly interest on N30M from 28/5/2025, the date the consent judgment was entered until the N30 Million is paid.
- (iii) Employment of five (5) members of the Okon Etukudo Uko family as agreed upon in the terms of settlement and as pronounced in the consent judgment.

- 3.2 An order directing the company to cease further work or activities on or quit the Okon Etukudo Uko family lands until 3.1- 3.2 above are obeyed and implemented by the company in the ALTERNATIVE the company should leave the lands and restore all the she has destroyed on the lands.
- 3.3 N100 Million as compensation to the family for the emotional, psychological/ physical stress and deprivation of the family that the company has put the family to.

#### **UDO AMAKA INAM FAMILY:**

- 4.1 In respect of Udo Amaka Inam family, the company grabbed and encroached on two lands/oil palm plantations upon which the family took out two different suits against the company.

**A: Suit No: HAB/9/2024: MR. EMEDIONG UDO AMAKA & ANOR V. STERLING PETROCHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS LIMITED:** In this case the company again opted for an amicable settlement out of court, drafted the terms of settlement which both parties signed and adopted openly in court upon which the court entered a consent judgment. Please find annexed hereto;

- (a) The **Terms of Settlement** drafted, signed and adopted in court by both parties; as **Annexure 32**.
- (b) The **Record Of Proceedings** showing what transpired in court on the day the terms of settlement was adopted by both parties, as **Annexure 33**.
- (c) The **Consent Judgment** order as **Annexure 34**.

Till date the company has refused and neglected to honour the terms of settlement and consent judgment.

## 5.0 PRAYERS SOUGHT:

- 5.1 An order compelling the company to obey, honour and implement the terms of settlement and consent judgment by:
- (i) Paying to the family through its Solicitor the sum of N10 Million as agreed and ordered by the court.
  - (ii) Employment of three(3) members of the family as agreed in the terms of settlement and consent judgment.
- 5.2 Payment of 10% monthly interest on N10M from 2/5/2025, the date the consent judgment was entered, until the N10 Million is paid and the three (3) family members are employed.
- 5.3 An order directing the company to cease further work or activities on the land or quit the land until 5.1- 5.2 above are obeyed and implemented by the company or in the **ALTERNATIVE**, the company should leave the land and restore the land to its original nature and position before the unlawful entry.
- 5.4 N50 million as compensation to the family for the loss to the family for the loss of the use of the land and the emotional/psychological/ physical stress the company has put the family to.

**B: Suit No: HAB/1/2025: MR. EMEDIONG UDO AMAKA & ANOR. V STERLING PETROCHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS LIMITED:** In this case as in other cases the company tricked the family into accepting settlement out of court, drafted the terms of settlement which was signed by both parties and adopted in open court upon which the court entered a consent judgment.

The Terms Of Settlement is annexed hereto as **Annexure 35** while the **Consent Judgment Order** is **Annexure 36**. In its usual manner, the company has refused to honour the terms of settlement and even the order of injunction made by the court as shown in **Annexure 37**.

## PRAYERS SOUGHT:

- 6.1 An order compelling the company to obey and implement the terms of settlement and consent judgment by:
- (i) Paying to the family through its Solicitor the sum of N46,050,000.00 as agreed in the terms of settlement and consent judgment.
  - (ii) Employing five (5) members of the family of the family as agreed in the terms of settlement and consent judgment.
- 6.2 Payment of 10% monthly interest on N46, 050,000.00 from 4/3/2025 when the consent judgment was entered, till the amount of N46,050,000.00 is paid and the five (5) members of the family are employed.
- 6.3 An order directing the company to cease further work or activities on the land or quit the land until 6.1- 6.2 are obeyed and implemented by the company or in the **ALTERNATIVE**, the company should leave the land and restore the land to its original state before the unlawful entry.
- 6.4 N100 Million as compensation to the family for the loss of use of the land and the emotional/psychological and physical stress/trauma the company has exposed the family to.

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**TERMS OF SETTLEMENT**

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**A. WHEREAS:**

1. The Claimant commenced this action against the Defendant by a Writ of Summons dated 6th January 2025, seeking the following reliefs:
  - a. A declaration that the forceful entry by the Defendant through her agents and servants into the piece of land known as and called Uko Okopedi Farm situate at Okopedi - Ete, Ukpum Ete, Ikot Abasi Local Government Area which is in the peaceful and quiet possession/use of the Claimant is wrongful and illegal
  - b. An order of perpetual injunction restraining the Defendant whether by herself, her agents, privies, representatives or servants or howsoever and whosoever from further entry into the said piece of land to do any manner or form of work whatsoever.
  - c. N100 million damages.
  - d. N2 million as cost of this action
2. Notwithstanding the above, the parties engaged in negotiations with the aim of reaching an amicable settlement of the claim.
3. Following the above deliberations, the parties have now arrived at a mutually agreeable settlement of the matter.

## **THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS**

1. The Defendant shall pay to the Claimant the sum of N30,000,000.00 (Thirty Million Naira only) as full and final settlement of the Claimant's claim referenced above and as contained on the writ of summons dated 6<sup>th</sup> January 2025 pertaining to the 8,305 square meters of land known as and called Uko Okopedi Farm situate, being and located at Okopedi - Ete, Ukpum Ete, Ikot Abasi Local Government Area of Akwa Ibom State, which is in the peaceful and quiet possession/use of the Claimant.
2. The payment of the said N30,000,000.00 (Thirty Million Naira only) by the Defendant to the Claimant shall also be deemed as consideration for the total acquisition of the subject matter land, that is, the 8,305 square meters of land known as and called Uko Okopedi Farm situate, being and located at Okopedi - Ete, Ukpum Ete, Ikot Abasi Local Government Area of Akwa Ibom State, which is owned and in the peaceful and quiet possession/use of the Claimant.
3. The Parties herein (Claimant and Defendant) shall execute a Deed of Assignment transferring and assigning title in the subject land to the Defendant absolutely, in fee simple possession.
4. The following persons shall be employed by the Defendant permanently in the following positions:
  - i. UKO OKON UKO - HSE OFFICER
  - ii. IME OKON UKO - COMPUTER OPERATOR
  - iii. MFONISO OKON UKO - DRIVER
  - iv. ROSELINE OKON UKO - OFFICE ASSISTANT
  - v. UWEM OKON UKO - LABOUR

Subject to the Claimant having a right to substitution any of the named persons.

The Defendant shall pay the agreed sum of N30,000,000.00 (Thirty Million Naira only) to the Claimant through the Claimant's solicitor, with the following particulars:

5. The Terms of Settlement herein shall be adopted and pronounced upon as the judgement of the Honourable Court in this suit.
6. It is further agreed that in the event of the absence of any of the parties or Counsel to attend Court on the day this suit is fixed for hearing or any proceedings for adoption of this terms of settlement, such absence shall not preclude any of the parties herein present in court or counsel in that behalf, from bringing this settlement to the attention of the court and adopting the same for/as the judgement of the court.
7. This terms of settlement shall be binding on the parties herein, their assigns, privies, and successors-in-title, and shall be the full and final settlement of this matter and all the issues connected with or pertaining to the claims against the Defendant in this suit.





As a supporter of your company to succeed in my community, I did not object to allow the road to go through my plantation provided I am compensated for my damaged crops. That was accepted by the company.

I am the first victim of your company that destroyed my personal properties without any compensation nor any of my family members working there. Can you imagine that?

Please sir, I have lost Thousands of Naira I could have gotten from sales of my oil palm fruits from my plantation to care for myself and my family and to settle other liabilities for the past one year and three months since you destroyed my crops.

I hope you will expedite action and settle me soon and give me jobs for my children. I am patient enough.
